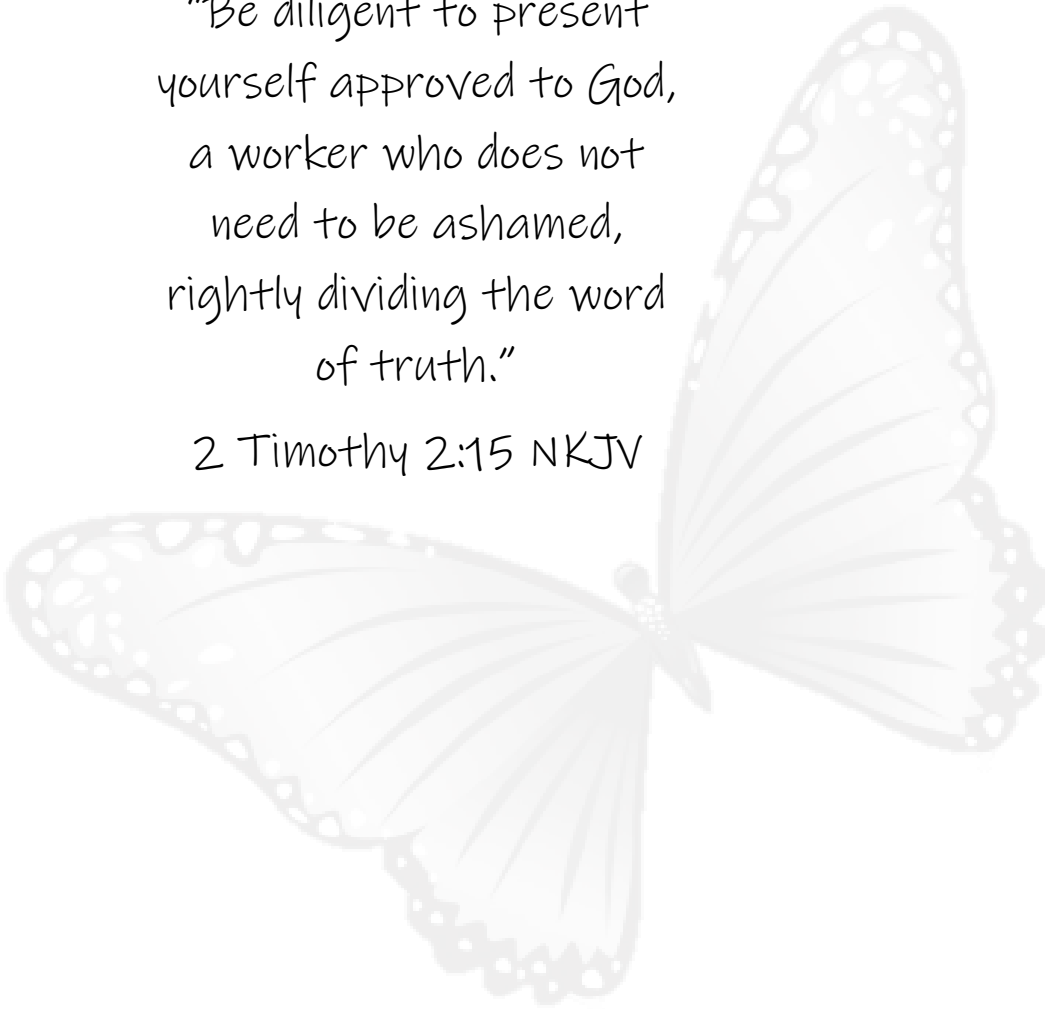



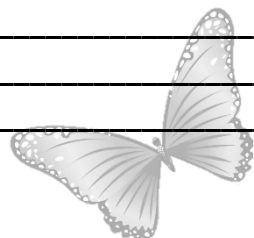

Write down a few thoughts that stuck out to you as you read.

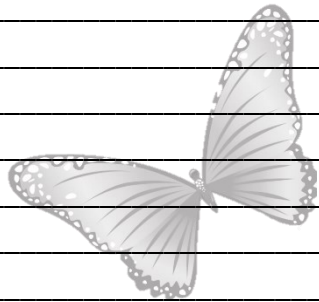
Pick one main thought from this list that you want to expand on. Why does this one interest you the most? Ask God to give you more understanding on this thought. Write down what comes to mind.

Write down why you think God gave us The Holy Spirit.




Write down what Acts 1:8 (NKJV) (2) means to you. Listen and write down what God may say to you about it.

“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witness in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”



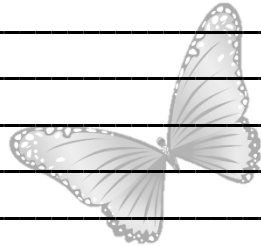

What is the importance of collaboration? What are some outcomes that can happen when collaboration occurs?




Write down what John 14:16-17 says about who The Holy Spirit is. What does this mean to you?

Write down the definition of the word *Advisor*. Does it make sense to call The Holy Spirit this? If so, why and if not, why?



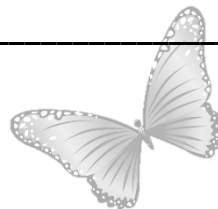
What does the power of suggestion mean to you? Is this in line with what you have read? What else is God sharing with you about this concept?

Do you think you could see the lies of the devil without help? What does John 15:5 say about this? Meditate on this.



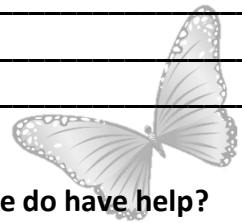
Write out Matthew 7:15-17 and what does it mean to you.

The disciples had help from Jesus when He was here. You have help from The Holy Spirit now. Why is it important to know you are not alone? Ask God to show you more about this.

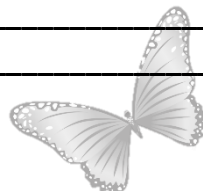


Write out Acts 19:4-6. Does this show that we do have help?

Write down what Proverbs 12:22 says. What does this mean to you?




What happen when a person denies that God is real? What does this say about Jesus or The Holy Spirit?

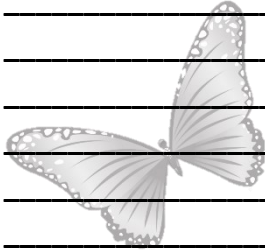
What does absolute truth meant to you? Does what you have read fall in line with this thought? Why or why not?



What does sober thinking have to do The Word of God? What does the word infallible mean according to page 38? Why does the devil want you to second guess The Word of God?

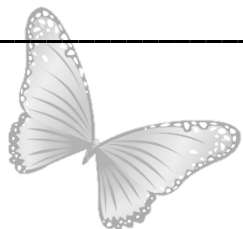
**List 3 things that show you how God made things to operate?

Do you need help in your daily life? Why or why not? How do you see The Holy Spirit helping you?

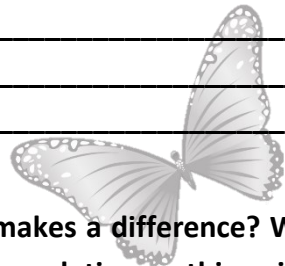


What does the concept of something being unchangeable mean to you? What does The Bible have to say about this?

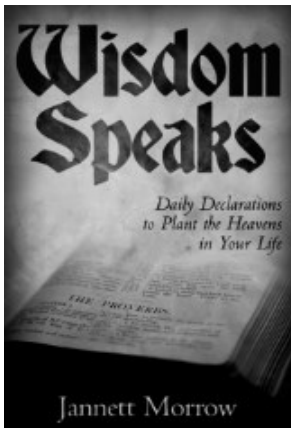
