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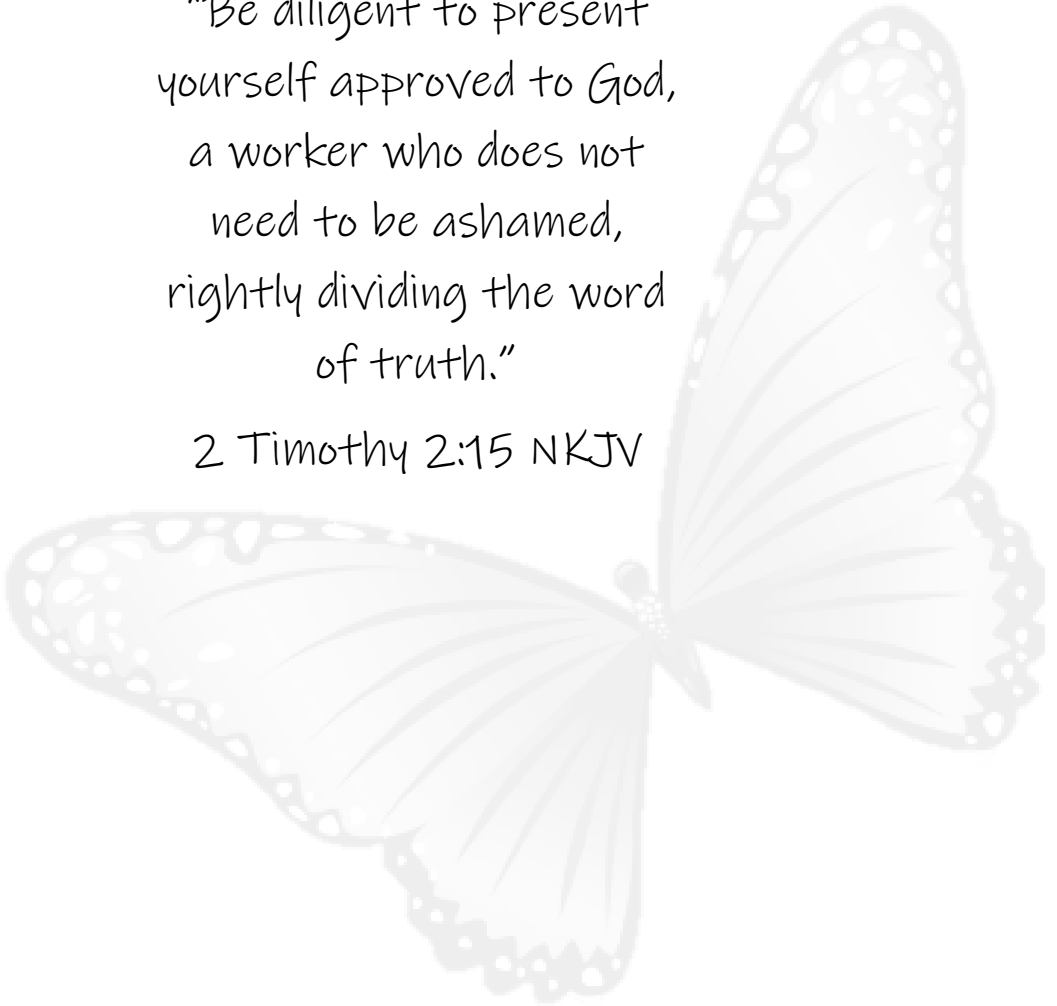

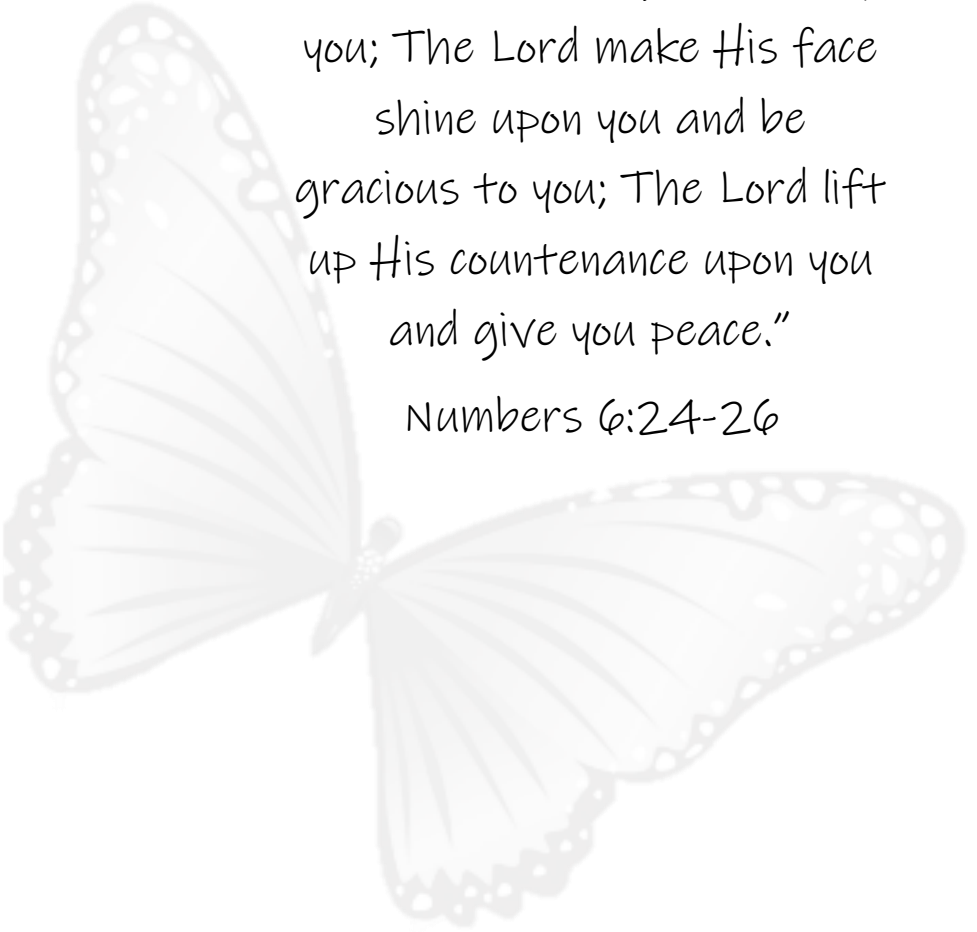

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**What does being complete mean to you?**

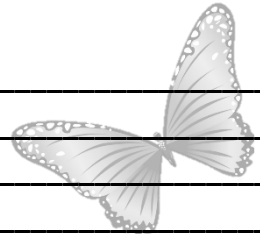
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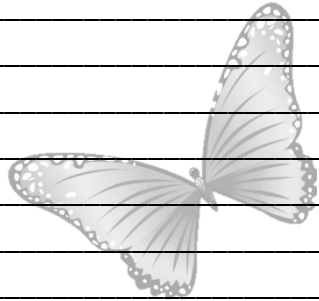
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**Write down what Numbers 6:24-26 (NKJV) (2) means to you. Listen and write down what God may say to you about it.**

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**Write down Romans 2:11. What does this mean to you?**

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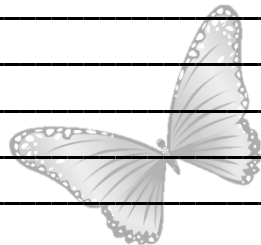
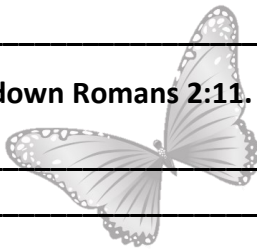
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**Write down the definition of *Respecter*. Does this fall in line with what you have read? Why or why not?**

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**What thoughts do you have about what happens when there is disunity? How does God want this to be fixed? Is it possible? Why or why not?**

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
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**God has predestined us to prosper. What does prospering look like for you right now? Is something missing? Why or why not?**

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**What does being complete mean to you? What does it mean to God?**

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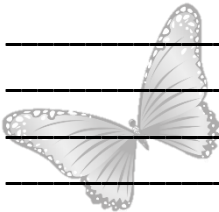
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**What does wholeness mean? How different is it from what completeness means? Ask God to make this clear to you.**

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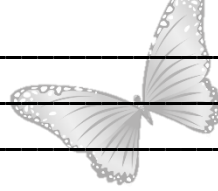
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**How early does the devil start to inject his influence? Can you think of when you realized he started with you? Ask God to show you. Write down what comes to mind.**

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**What happens when lies become your reality? Write down some examples that come to mind.**

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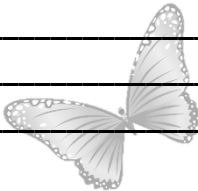
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**What does Matthew 9:20-22 mean to you?**

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**What is the importance of understanding why we need to keep our trust in God? Ask God to make this clearer to you.**

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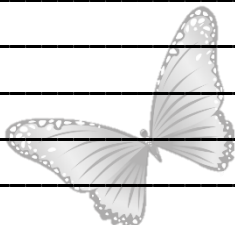
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**Write down Mark 5:27-29. What does this have to do with your thinking?**

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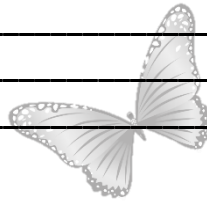
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**Where does your healing come from? What is a lie that the devil told you about you being healed? What does God say about this?**

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**What does Shalom mean to you? Why is it important to know what God means about Shalom?**

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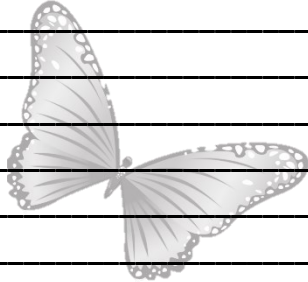

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**How much toil is connected with doing things God’s way? How much peace is there in toiling? What does Matthew 8:23-25 have to say about this?**

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
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**What are some points that have helped you to grow more and develop in your walk, as you have read this book series?**

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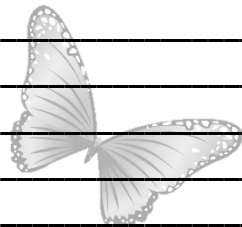
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**Ask God to show you areas that you need to grow and develop more in. Write down what comes to mind. Pray for The Holy Spirit to help you with these areas.**



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**Why does God want or need our hearts to be changed? How does the right heart help you to fulfill your purpose?**

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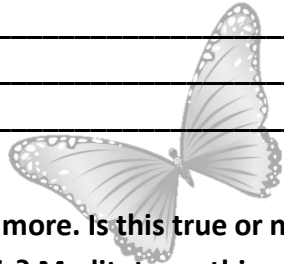
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**Doing good deeds makes God love you more. Is this true or not? What does Romans 10:13 say about this? Meditate on this.**

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**Write down John 3:16. How important is it for you to know this truth? What does this have to do with Shalom?**

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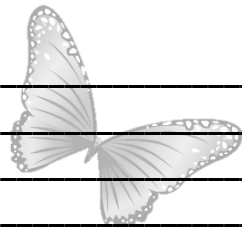
